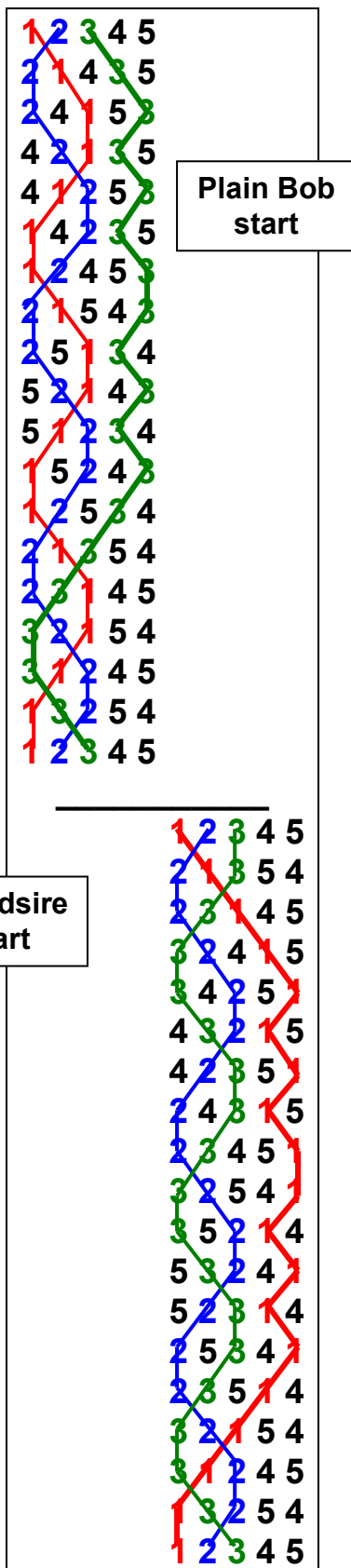


Stedman quick sixes (Cloister Doubles)

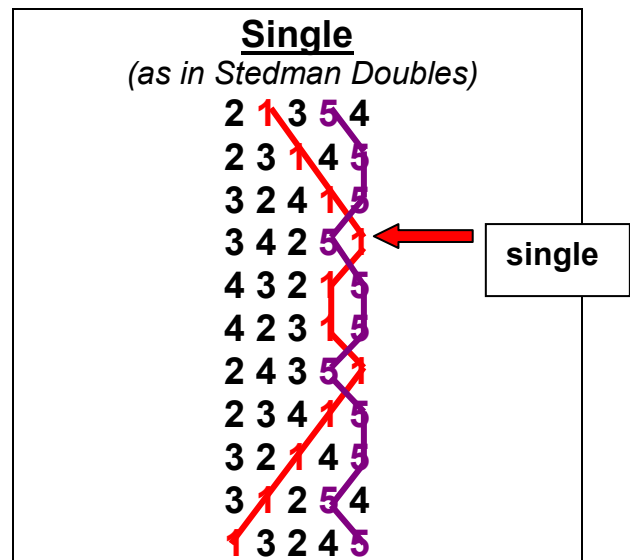


Two bells hunt to thirds place.
 With a Plain Bob start
 it is the treble and the two.
 With a Grandsire start it is the
 two and the three.

*It is very useful for ringers
 learning to hunt as the ropesight
 is very easy.*

The other bells double dodge
 4/5 up, lie and double dodge
 4/5 down.

*The single is the same as in
 Stedman, and provides an
 easier way to practise ringing
cat's ears and coat hangers
 before ringing them in Stedman.*



For a simple touch the conductor calls himself to
 make the single with the same bell twice
