
The order of passing bells at 3-4 dodges in Plain Bob



Notes

- The upper diagram is 3-4 UP dodge.
- The lower diagram is 3-4 DOWN dodge.
- You are ringing the Blue bell.
- The numbers are your count.
- For completeness the full work of A & B is shown. i.e. In the upper diagram B is dodging 3-4 DOWN and A is making 2nds to the Treble.
- The important difference between the two dodges (up & down) is where you meet the Treble. Think of the dodges as a short "Blip" in the general direction you are going in. If you are dodging UP your general direction is UP – If you are dodging down your general direction is down.
- In BOTH cases you follow the treble in 3 when you are nearest the front. In 3-4 up this will be just before the dodge in 3-4 down it will be just after the dodge.
