
An approach to teaching Stedman



Stedman can be taught with very encouraging results using the system outlined below.

The method is broken down into lessons and the targeted learner can concentrate on each lesson at a time to achieve understanding and confidence.

All the learner's work is directed to the front three bells. Change repetition occurs but the result is pleasant to the ear.

Notes:

- 1. This practice only requires two *Stedman* ringers and two rounds ringers plus the *Stedman* learner.
- 2. The Stedman learner takes the blue line bell.
- Stedman ringers ring conventional Stedman except for long thirds between quick and slow work.
