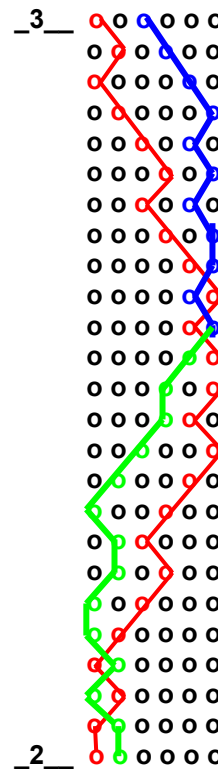
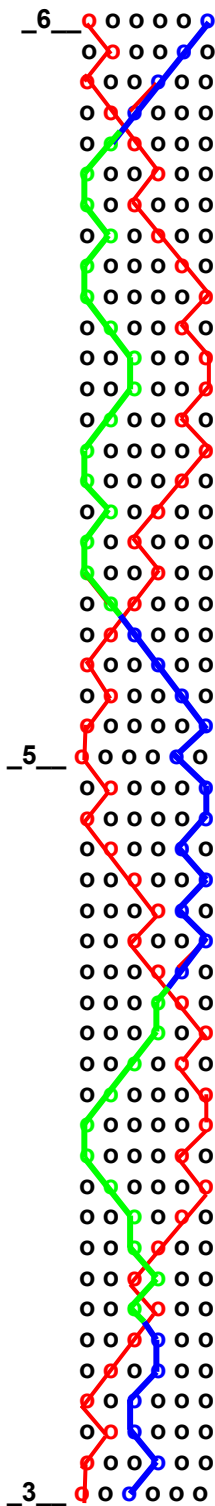
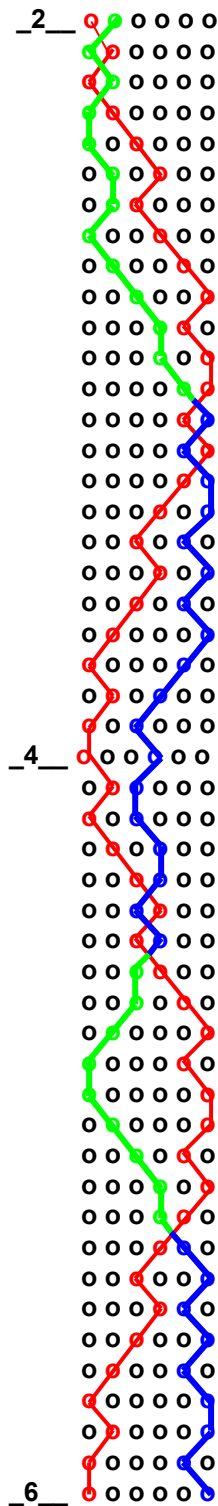


London below - **York Surprise Minor** - Cambridge above



Certain Surprise Minor methods are formed by ringing one method when ringing below the treble and a different one when ringing above the treble. The ringer changes from one method to the other as he passes the treble.

**York** consists of **London** below the treble and **Cambridge** above.

There are 41 regular Surprise Minor Methods which can be formed in the same way. See table on following page.
