

Index

Only the first occurrence of a term on a page is indexed, and it may occur more than once. Ringers' names are not indexed, unless there is a specific news item relating to them, and these are grouped together. Also, modern terminology is used, so that, for example, Grandsire Bob Triples has been indexed as Plain Bob Triples, and Union Treble Bob is indexed as Oxford Treble Bob. The index as constructed is hierarchical, that is, a dash refers to the heading above. Thus for, instance, in the pair of entries

Ashford, Kent 2,18,21,29,116,196,199

- ringers 116,172

the second line would refer to Ashford ringers. County names used are those appertaining at the time.

Because of the substantial appendices, pages 1-202 and 271 cover the period 1830-1839, pages 203-226 the period up to 1799, and pages 227-270 the period 1800-1829. Thus pages 203-270 report on events prior to 1830. The dates of some of the earliest newspapers are the old style, so that the reference *Ipswich Gazette*, Sat. 8 Nov. - Sat. 15 Nov. 1735 indicates that the newspaper was reporting for that period, and was published on Sat. 15 Nov. 1735.
