Two bells in brass with legend 'Ring in 2000' Long diagonal 26mm

Produced for the millennium, and sold to all ringers and not just Council members

Pin fastening with plain reverse No manufacturer shown, but known to be Andrew Gordon

Medallion/Badge: It is intended to produce a bronze badge in the design of the two bells RI2000 logo. The cost of the die is borne by the Central Council Public Relations Advisory Group. The price of the badge will be £3 incl. P&P.
