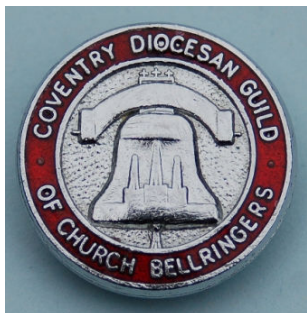


COVENTRY DIOCESAN GUILD (founded 1946)

'A proposal that the Guild should have a badge designed brought forth a number of speakers in agreement, and the hon. secretary was instructed to proceed with enquiries and report to the next meeting' *'The Ringing World' 11.xi.1948 p546*

'Chief business was the discussion on designs for a Guild badge. These had been prepared by Mr W B Ellender (Stoke, Coventry band), and one was approved. An order was placed for two gross. The badge would be in enamel and chromium, and the estimated cost was 3s. each.' *'The Ringing World' 3.ii.1950 p76*

'Guild badges had been purchased to the design decided upon by the members at the previous quarterly meeting and were on sale at 3s. each.' *'The Ringing World' 5.v.1950 p282*

'Guild badges were to be reduced to 2s. each.' *'The Ringing World' 22.v.1959 p334*
