
COVENTRY DIOCESAN GUILD (founded 1946)

'A proposal that the Guild should have a badge designed brought forth a number of speakers in agreement, and the hon. secretary was instructed to proceed with enquiries and report to the next meeting' *'The Ringing World' 11.xi.1948 p546*

'Chief business was the discussion on designs for a Guild badge. These had been prepared by Mr W B Ellender (Stoke, Coventry band), and one was approved. An order was placed for two gross. The badge would be in enamel and chromium, and the estimated cost was 3s. each.' 'The Ringing World' 3.ii.1950 p76

'Guild badges had been purchased to the design decided upon by the members at the previous quarterly meeting and were on sale at 3s. each.' *'The Ringing World'* 5.v.1950 p282

'Guild badges were to be reduced to 2s. each.' 'The Ringing World' 22.v.1959 p334
