Buttonhole fastening with plain reverse Manufactured by 'VAUGHTONS LTD / B'HAM' or none shown

Circular, cupronickel with light blue enamel Diameter 15mm

Brooch fastening with plain reverse Manufactured by ' VAUGHTONS B'HAM'

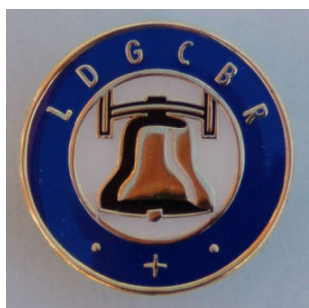


Version D Centenary Badge

The manufacturer was Richard Bett, Artist and Design Jeweller of Lincoln. He used the assay mark of Ian Keat, also of Lincoln (IGK), together with the anchor for the Birmingham assay office, but no date letter.
