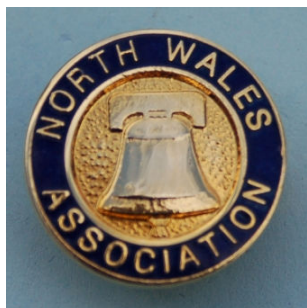

Circular, brass with blue enamel border Diameter 12mm

Brooch fastening with textured reverse Manufactured by 'INSIGNIA / 0181-669-3122'

### Version (Special) Silver watch chain medallion

Pendant for chain fastening Base has extra design in middle

On reverse shows manufacturer as 'H.S & SON' (possibly Henry Slingsby and Son, who produced medals and commemoratives in Birmingham from 1903 onwards.)

The hallmarks are for Birmingham silver and the date letter 'k' is for 1909
