Circular, in cupronickel with cut out bell Diameter 30mm

Blue enamel outer ring, with yellow and red enamel shield on bell (worn off on example shown)

Brooch or buttonhole fastening with plain reverse 'DOWLER BIRMINGHAM' on horseshoe or none on brooch

'...a resolution asking for provision of a distinctive badge for Association membership. A design prepared by the Chaplain (Revd Leonard J Birch), and incorporating a bell having the Diocesan Crest, was considered at the Annual Meeting and it was decided to purchase two gross.' *W&DCRA annual report for 1954*

### Version C

Circular, in cupronickel with cut out bell Diameter 26mm

Blue enamel outer ring, with red enamel shield on bell

Stud fastening with plain reverse No manufacturer shown
