Handling pictures from chapters 2 & 3 of The New Ringer's Book

These pictures are the illustrations of handling from the two chapters *The New Ringer's Book* devoted to controlling a bell.

They are provided for readers who find the printed illustrations too small to be able to study the detailed points in the pictures as printed in the book.

They should be used in conjunction with the text that accompanies them in the printed book, which can be obtained from Central Council Publications <u>https://cccbr.org.uk/shop/</u>

All picture files are in JPEG format, and the file names are composed as follows. [....] means may not be present.

<page number> - <stage number> <view> [<sequence number> or <position>] [<c>]

- P<page number> This is the page in the printed book.
- <stage number> This is the stage in the cycle depicted. For ringing a bell full circle (Chapter 2.2) it runs from 1 to 18, as shown in the diagram on page 12. For raising a bell (chapter 3.3) it runs from 1 to 8, but action shots end at 6. For lowering a bell it runs from 1 to 7. (Chapter numbers are not included in the file names.)
- $\langle view \rangle F = Front, S = Side, C = Close-up.$
- <sequence number> [May not be present] Where several images on the same page and section appear down or across the page they are numbered in sequence.
- <position> [May not be present] Where pairs of images on the same page and section appear above each other, T = Top, B = Bottom, L = Left, R = Right.

So for example:

P14-2F is on page 13, illustrating step 2 of the cycle, a front view

P44-C3 is on page 44, the third in a series of close-ups

P48-3TS is on page 48, illustrating step 3 of the cycle, the top side view
