- 4. YellowYoYo Branding Collaboration. The first project review meeting will be held on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> November, with a report to the Executive at the December meeting.

- 9. CC Library Move. The Service Level Agreement between the CCCBR and the Loughborough Bell Foundry Trust has been received and signed. The very favourable rental fees were noted, and well as the insurance and arrangements for safe keeping of valuable documents.
