## Executive

Notes of the meeting held on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2025, by Zoom.

- The design work for the School Lesson Plan and the Youth Hub are progressing. In order to have a corporate image, the Executive accepted a quote from Yellow YoYo to produce design work for these projects. The cost is £850.00 (plus VAT).
- In view of a potential bequest, and with comments from the recent Annual Council Meeting, the Executive discussed a potential investment policy. It was felt that help from people with more experience in the financial arena was needed. The executive decided that there was a need to set up a financial task group to define the investment policy was needed. Several names were mentioned, and the Treasurer will pursue the setting up of this group.
- The Executive also looked at a funds committee, to assist the Treasurer with the management of investments and expenditure. They looked at the possibilities of obtaining financial advice. Again, several possible names were mentioned.
- The compilation of the 2026 budget is underway, with Workgroup Leads being asked for their contributions. The budget control form has been simplified to make the budget complication process simpler.
- The Executive considered the role of various Workgroups. It was noted that there is a need for administrative support for several groups, and as such, a notice has recently appeared on the social media channels. There is also an appeal via these channels, for people to help with the Marking Workgroup.
- The Executive was updated with the progress of the work being carried out, via the Summer Honorariums. It was recommended that an interim payment of £1000.00 be made to two of the young people involved
- No applications have yet been received from societies wishing to transfer to the new category of associated society. A process as to how any such applications should be processed is being put together, and as such, an update to the Standing Orders is planned.
- The request from The Association of Ringing Teachers regarding the university recruitment package (as discussed at the September Executive) has been further clarified. Further discussions with ART will be held on this topic.

The next meeting of the Executive will be on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> November 2025. There will be a meeting of the Executive at 10.00am and a joint meeting of the Executive and the Workgroup Leads at 11.00am.
