Notes of the meeting held on Wednesday 4th December 2025, by Zoom.

- A bank account at Cambridge and Counties Bank has been finally set up. Funds have been transferred into it from the Lloyds account. This gives a better interest rate.
- The 2026 Council Budget will be agreed at a meeting of the Executive on Sunday 14th December
- A request from the Publications team to purchase 200 copies of the New Ringers Book at a cost of £1200.00 was agreed.
- Angela Elliotts decision to stand down as the Councils Public Relations Officer was noted. The President expressed appreciation for her contributions to the work of the Council.
- Following the November WG Lead/Executive meeting, several WG leads have submitted progress reports. A document summarising these is being compiled and will be published in the Christmas issue of The Ringing World and distributed to representatives.
- The role of the Marketing Workgroup was discussed. The Executive will be holding an open meeting on Sunday 18th January 2026 (by Zoom) to discuss the Council marketing strategy, needs and resources. All affiliated societies will be invited.
- Durham University Society and the Guild of Clerical Ringers have applied to transfer to the new category Associated Society. These requests were approved by the Executive.
